The house has a gas supply that meets the basic needs of her and her family and there is an adequate access to water for drinking and domestic use. There are adequate sanitation facilities available and the electricity supply is unreliable and does not meet family needs.

Ghinwa's family do not own any land. The family do not own any livestock.

Ghinwa's Education

Ghinwa is currently learning a trade through vocational training where she is making good progress. Reports show that her attendance is excellent.

Ghinwa uses public transport to get to school and it takes her about 15 minutes.

Ghinwa's Health

Ghinwa is in good general health for her age and she is generally fit.

Ghinwa's nearest doctor is less than an hour away and she visits the doctor every year for a medical checkup.

In case of an emergency, the nearest hospital is less than an hour away.
